

Admissions Process and Requirements

1-School Tour

All applicants and their parents/guardians should visit the School. This important part of the admissions process allows the School and family to become better acquainted. School tours are scheduled by appointment.

2-Application

The admissions process officially begins with the submission of a completed application for enrollment and a \$75 non-refundable application fee. Teacher recommendations are required prior to testing and interview.

3-Campus Visit & Assessment

We encourage any prospective student to spend a day with their respective class. This visit is at no obligation and gives the student and family a good idea of the culture of Silverwood School. Visits will be scheduled in advance by the office. Students applying are given a basic entrance assessment prior to acceptance. This may be done during their Campus Visit or we can schedule another convenient time to do this.

4-Family Interview

Applicants and parents will interview with the Head of School. The interview is scheduled after the Campus Visit and Admissions Assessment. This interview is an opportunity for parents to ask questions and for the School to get to know your family better.

Enrollment

After the family interview, the admissions decision will be made and communicated to the family. Once an enrollment agreement has been offered, the student is considered enrolled when the signed enrollment agreement has been returned to the school and the first tuition payment has been made. Next, vaccination records, previous school records, and back-to-school paperwork must be turned in to the office.
